

FARM COOLER S.O.P

The Farber Farm walk-in cooler is where all post harvest produce is stored

- There are two racks in the walk-in cooler, one for program/dining hall vegetables and one for “family” vegetables. **NO PROGRAM OR DINING HALL VEGETABLES ARE TO BE TAKEN BY STAFF OR VISITORS.** Staff and visitors may mindfully share in produce on the “family” (farm-family) shelf. These racks will be clearly labeled and there should be no reason for confusion.
- The farm cooler is accessible to staff and volunteers only. At no point should program participants or family camp participants enter the farm cooler unsupervised.
- Clean shoes must be worn inside of the cooler. If shoes are muddy, please stomp off dirt before entry.
- Produce is accessible during farm hours only when farm staff are present to assist. Please do not come to take produce from cooler after hours.
- Farm cooler is to be swept 3x per week and sanitized monthly to ensure a clean environment for produce storage.
- Cooler door is only to stay open upon entry and exit. Please close the door behind you when in the cooler to ensure vegetables stay at the correct storage temperature.
- Cooler is only to be entered to retrieve produce. Please do not hang out in the cooler during hot times of the day.
- Farm manager will keep inventory of vegetables in cooler.
- Washed produce **ONLY** in cooler.
