

Scavenger Hunt at the Farm

Class Length:

1 hour 15 minutes

Class Number:

Up to 30 participants

Location:

Farm

Age:

1st – 8th grade

Materials:

- Scavenger hunt check list
- Oil marker or dry erase

Class Set-Up:

- Chaperones must be supervising kids throughout the farm
- Activity leader must be ready to give directions with check lists

Safety Precautions:

- Kids and chaperones must only stay on the gravel pathways, unless otherwise indicated
- Absolutely no running throughout the farm
- Awareness of tubing and pipes running above ground, as well as farm tools

Introduction:

Participants will be taken on a tour of the farm, where they will learn about all the different areas and programs we have going on. They will be led on an interactive tour through the gardens, the greenhouse, and the hoop house. Everyone will be allowed to pick an herb to taste.

The group will then be split into equal teams. Each team will go off in search for the items on their check list. This can be done individually, with a meetup at the end, or as a whole group. 5 minutes to the end we will announce you have 2 more minutes. At the 3 minute mark, teams will come together and show which items they have found.

- Explanation of scavenger hunt goals, and description of safety precautions/rules

Class teardown:

Collect all scavenger hunt check lists and oil pens or dry erase markers, wipe sheets clean between each round and at the end.
