

Logging S.O.P

Field Log- Fill out hard copy field log after each of the following

- Seeding
- Field planting (direct seed and transplant)
- Applying amendments of any kind (eggshells, compost tea, fish emulsion, compost, minerals, etc)
- Applying approved insecticides/fungicides of any kind

We want to keep track of all inputs, seed amounts, plant amounts, varieties, conditions and as much detailed information as possible. This will help us reflect on concrete information and adjust/improve year after year.

Harvest Log- Fill out hard copy harvest log (in LBS) after the following

- Scheduled harvests
- Individual harvests
- Group tours with harvesting (estimate if you must)

By tracking our yields after each harvest, we will have hard data at the end of the season to reflect on and report to our donors, farm committee, board members and all other interested parties. This data will help us determine our crop plan for the following year and how we can improve or make changes. Keeping this data as one unit (LBS) will help with ease of tracking.
